What fun it is to laugh and sing a sleighing song to-night.

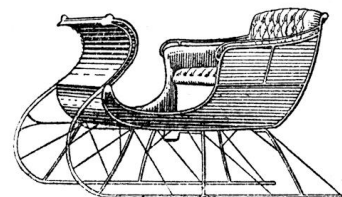
He got into drifted bank And then we got up-sot.
