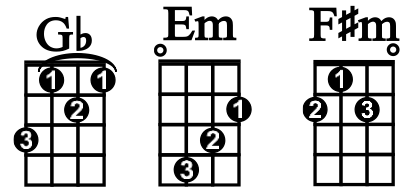


Lookin' Out My Back Door in G and A

Intro:

|G |Em |C / G / |D / G /



Verse 1:

|G |Em
Just got home from Illinois, lock the front door, oh boy !

|C / G / |D
Got to sit down, take a rest on the porch.

|G |Em
Imagination sets in, pretty soon I'm singing,

|C / G / |D / G /
doo, doo, doo, lookin' out my back door.

Verse 2:

|G |Em
There's a giant doing cartwheels, a statue wearin' high heels,

|C / G / |D
look at all the happy creatures dancing on the lawn.

|G |Em
A dinosaur Victrola, listening to Buck Owens

|C / G / |D / G /
doo, doo, doo, lookin' out my back door.

Bridge:

|D |C / G /
Tambourines and elephants are playing in the band,

|G / Em / |D
won't you take a ride on the flyin' spoon? (Doo do doo)

|G^{Solo} |Em
Wond'rous apparition, provided by magician,

|C / G / |D / G /
doo, doo, doo, lookin' out my back door.

Lookin' Out My Back Door - 2

Instrumental:

|G |Em |C / G / |D |G |Em |C / G / |D / G /

Bridge:

|D |C / G /
Tambourines and elephants are playing in the band,

|G / Em / |D
won't you take a ride on the flyin' spoon? (Doo do doo)

|G ^{Solo} |Em
Bother me tomorrow, to- day I'll buy no sorrows,

|C / G / |D / G /
doo, doo, doo, lookin' out my back door.

INSTRUMENTAL: Leading to key change

^{Fast run down}
|G stop | ---G G^b F |E |D / A / |A / F[#]m / |E

Verse 3 – KEY CHANGE TO A:

|A |F[#]m
Forward troubles Illinois, lock the front door, oh boy !
^{Accent last 3 beats to slow down}

|D / A / |E⁷ ///
Look at all the happy creatures dancing on the lawn.
^{Slow down}

|A |A |F[#]m |F[#]m
Bother me to- morrow, to- day I'll buy no sorrows

|D |A |E⁷ |A
doo, doo, doo, lookin' out my back door.

Outro – FULL SPEED – drums cue change:

|D / A / |E⁷ / A / hold
