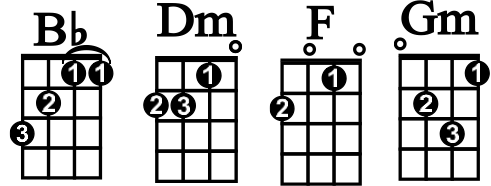


Wayfaring Stranger in Dm
